QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS TO W9128A-04-B-0005

Q2. How can a contractor be expected to dredge Manele Small Boat Harbor as specified in the current contract solicitation since hydraulic dredging will most likely produce a slurry with high percent water and low percent solids and generate a volume of water necessitating surficial drainage and return water into the harbor?

A2. Although we are not directing the precise dredging and dewatering methods or equipment to be used in the Manele Small Boat Harbor dredging operation, the specification of no return water back into harbor and the dimensions of the designated dewatering area may preclude certain means of dredging and associated dredging equipment from being utilized to accomplish the work. Methods and equipment that enable dredging of sediment with low initial water content and enhance the sub-drainage characteristics of the designated dewatering water area may need to be considered to effectively and efficiently process the material prior to its disposal at the county landfill. It is our expectation that the dredging industry will be able to conduct their activities within existing environmental thresholds even though those environmental considerations may preclude methods by which similar work has been accomplished in the past.

Q3. If the water does not sub-drain from the designated dewatering area, what will be the financial impact to the US Army Corps of Engineers with regard to "differing site conditions" and standby for equipment and personnel?

A3. If a "differing site conditions" claim is filed by the selected contractor in connection with the suitability of the project design, it will be evaluated at that time to determine the appropriate action to be taken and the ultimate compensation to be awarded if any. We do not believe the site differs from the conditions outlined in the IFB.

**Q4. I am reviewing the Manele Bay dredging job in Lanai and I noticed you guys did the pre-dredge survey. Did you run any quantities on these surveys? If so, can I get them to check our quantities?**

**A4. Pre-dredge quantities will not be provided.**
