Q18. From Golbie Kamarei, LYZ, Inc., e-mail dated 4/21/04:

Regarding 00120-6 (AM-0001), 2.4.4 Factor III, Management Plan: Are the Contract Quality Control System Manager and the Quality Control Representative the only two positions that need to be employed by the Prime Contractor? Do the individuals filling these positions need to be employed by the Prime Contractor at the time of proposal submission?

A18. Section 01451Q only requires the Contract Quality Control System Manager and the Quality Control Representative to be employed by the Prime Contractor. The individuals filling these positions do not need to be employed by the Prime Contractor at the time of proposal submission.

Q19. From Golbie Kamarei, LYZ, Inc., e-mail dated 4/21/04:

The Occupied Family Housing Personnel position is not identified in 00120-7 (AM-0001), but is identified in Section 01451Q, Page 11, 3.4.4.H. Is this a position we should articulate in our proposal?

A19. The requirement for the Occupied Family Housing Personnel position will be added to Section 00120.

Q20. From Golbie Kamarei, LYZ, Inc., e-mail dated 4/21/04:

Section 01451Q, Page 12, 3.4.5 Additional Requirement states "The CQC System Manager, all Quality Control Representatives, and any alternates shall have completed the course entitled "Construction Quality Management For Contractors" within the past five years."

In Section 00120-7 (AM-0001), Quality Control Personnel, Minimum Contract Requirement, it states "Completed 'Construction Quality Management for Contractor's' course within the past five years."

Could you please clarify, should ALL Quality Control PERSONNEL - who are brought in as consultants - have completed the "Construction Quality Management for Contractor's" course within the past five years or is it just the CQCSM and QCR?

A20. Section 00120 will be corrected and the phrase "Completed Construction Quality Management for Contractor's course within the past five years" will be deleted for "Quality Control Personnel".

Q21. From Ethan Twer, Designer Built Systems, email dated 4/23/04:

Please refer to specification section 00120.2.4.4 Factor III, Management Plan.

According to the table provided, it can be inferred that the Government's minimum contract requirements for ALL of the Quality Control Personnel include completion of the course entitled "Construction Quality Management for Contractors" within the last five years.

Is this required for ALL of the positions listed (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Structural, Architectural, Environmental, Submittals and Concrete Pavements and Soils)?

I understand that each individual task order may not require all of the QC Personnel shown, but I just want to make sure what the minimum contract requirements are before submitting our proposal.
